

Wanted: Blue Bird House Monitors

The Township has installed nesting boxes for blue birds on public lands. Volunteer blue bird house monitors are needed to perform the following stewardship tasks:

- Inspect the nest boxes prior to the nesting season, remove debris from the previous season, make sure the boxes are in good condition, and report needed repairs to the Township staff.
- Check the boxes at two-week intervals during the nesting season, record which boxes are occupied by blue birds and how many eggs or young are in each nest.
- Complete a report form at the end of the nesting season and submit it to the Township Natural Resources Commission.
